Mandatory Competitions

Interview



35% of score

Interview will allow delegates one on one time with judges. Jr. divisions will have a 2 minute panel style interview & Sr. divisions will have 3 minute panel style interview.

There is no required icebreaker, timer will start the moment delegate begins to speak. Questions will come

from list on next page.

Fun Fashion



30% of score

Fun fashion is a chance for delegates to show their personal sense of style and modeling. Candidates can choose any outfit they wish. (Think high fashion).

Evening Gown



35% of score*

Evening gown is the opportunity for delegates to showcase their elegance and grace. Candidates may choose any gown but it must be a floor length gown.

What is Outstanding Miss?

Outstanding Miss are our two other national titles. Delegate must be entered into mandatory events and then may enter this competition. These two winners are awarded the exact same crown, prize package and recognition as the other six queens division but with their title will be American United Outstanding Junior Miss.

*Outstanding delegates will be scored separately. Their scores will be compromised of 60% community service scrapbook, 25% interview score & 15% Evening Gown score. Scrapbook will be judged based on quality and quantity of community service not necessarily artistic ability. Scrapbooks can be digital or hardback and will should be turned in at registration. If you do a digital video it must be uploaded to a flash drive and labeled with name & event.

Print Model Photo

Delegates may submit as many photographs as they choose. \$75 for first entry, and each additional is \$50. Only the judges favorite photo will be scored. Entries will be judged on personality and overall beauty and quality of the photo. One winner from each age division will be selected. We suggest the type of photo you may see in a magazine.

National Cover Model

This winner will be made up of the highest combined scores from all three of the photo optional events. There will be one overall winner chosen from all of the divisions. Winner will receive a crown, sash, award and \$200 cash scholarship

Optional Competitions

Casual Wear

Strut the runway and show the judges your fun and casual side!

Delegates can model an outfit of their choosing that shows their personality and style. These can be off the rack. Scores are not factored into overall placement but one winner from each division will be named.

Fitness Wear

Show us your modeling while showing off your best fitness attire.

Delegates should choose an active wear that suits your personality.

Scores are not factored into overall placement but one winner from each division will be named.

State Wear

Here's you chance to really let your creativity shine! Delegates can model an outfit of their choosing that represents their state, region or title. A costume description will be submitted to be read while delegate models this outfit. Scores are not factored into overall placement but one winner from each division will be named.

National Super Model

This winner will be made up of the highest combined scores from all three of the stage optional events. There will be one overall winner chosen from all of the divisions. Winner will receive a crown, sash, award and \$200 cash scholarship

Talent

Show us your talent! Simply submit a 2 minute video of you performing your talent. All talent submissions should be no longer than 2 minutes and must be prerecorded and uploaded to a flash drive to turn in at registration for judging. Scores are not factored into overall placement but there will be one winner per age division as well as one overall winner. \$75 Entry Fee

Spokesmodel

Delegate presents a prerecorded speech based on the subject of their choice. Speech can be between 30 to 60 seconds. Scores are not factored into overall placement but one Jr. Division & one Sr. Division winner will be named. \$75 entry Fee

Strike A Pose Photoshoot Competition

Here's you chance to strike a pose in front of the amazing Mark Farmer's lens!! Attire is delegates choice but must be a pastel color or floral. The best photo of each delegate will be sent for judging. Scores are not factored into overall placement but one Jr. Division & one Sr. Division winner will be named. \$75 entry fee

Overall Jackpots

Overall Interview Jackpot - \$25 cash entry fee Overall Community Service Scrapbook Jackpot - \$25 cash entry fee Overall Fun Fashion Jackpot - \$25 cash entry fee Overall Evening Gown Jackpot - \$25 cash entry fee

Pules

Modeling should not be "over the top" no glitz or "pro am" routines in any age division.

There will only be one chaperone allowed in changing areas with each delegate but no men will be permitted. No chaperones will be allowed to wait with delegates once line up is happening.

No poor sportsmanship during any portion of the competitions. If this is witnessed, then you will be asked to leave immediately with no refund!

No refunds unless event is canceled & not rescheduled.

We do not have a non-compete however we do ask our national queens to only compete in other non binding systems during their reign.

Hair and makeup rules for all ages are as follows:

Makeup Buidelines

All hair and makeup should be age appropriate for every phase of competition. Hair extensions, eyelashes and tans are allowed but this is not a glitz a pageant.

Sponsored Ad pages are optional if going for the age division sweetheart title or AUM Ambassador title. The contestant in each age division with the most sold Ad pages will receive the age division Sweetheart title & the contestant with the most sold ad pages in the entire pageant will be crowned AUM Ambassador.

Ad Page Creation Fee is \$30 paid to the national office unless you have already had one made.


Ad Pages Fee is \$200 per page paid to the American United Miss National Office. Link to pay is in the Contestant Portal.








Walking Pattern
